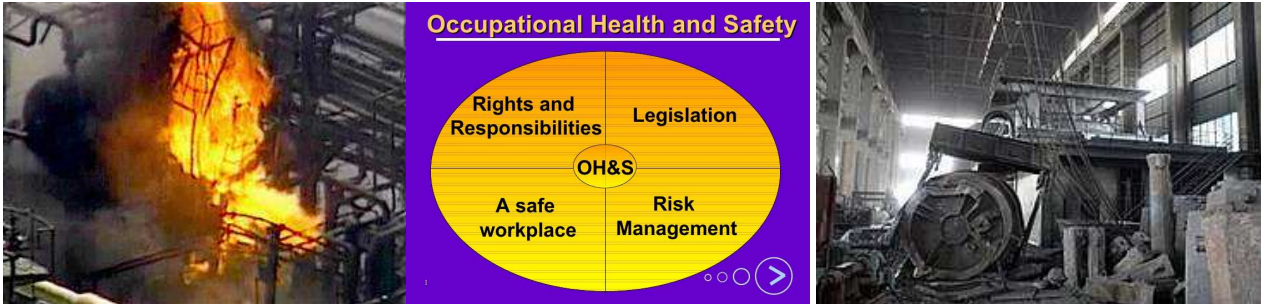

BUSINESS CHALLENGE – Why Occupational Health and Safety?

With more and more industrialization and transportation of goods across the globe, work related injuries, ill health and fatality is one of the greatest challenges for the mankind.

It is a challenge for industry to understand and prioritize the Occupational, Health and Safety hazards and risks in their business processes. The need for an internationally acceptable standard to systematically manage the hazards and risks and improve the performance was felt for a long time. International Organization for Standardization (ISO) has adopted various existing Health and safety standards (such as BS OHSAS 18001) and published ISO 45001 in 2018, which specifies the requirements for a management system to protect against and reduce the likelihood of occurrence of risks

SOLUTION

It is essential that all managerial and non managerial workmen are made fully aware of the hazards at workplace and the risks arising out of these hazards to the Safety of employees as well to the organization and methods to control them. It is also important that all employees are fully made aware of the applicable laws of the land and their provisions as applicable to their area of operations and consequences of not complying with the requirements. Formal training of employees is the right step in this direction

THE AIM

The aim of this course is to provide delegates with the knowledge and skills required to perform first, second and third-party audits of Occupational Health & Safety management systems against ISO 45001, in accordance with ISO 19011 and ISO 17021, as applicable. All references in this document to ISO standards are to the current versions unless stated otherwise.

Delegates who complete this CQI and IRCA Certified ISO 45001 Lead Auditor (OHSAS) Training course successfully (within the three years prior to making an application to become a certificated auditor) will satisfy the training requirements for initial certification as a CQI-IRCA Certificated OH&SMS auditor.

WHO CAN ATTEND

All those with responsibility to implement, maintain and improve an OH&SMS according to the ISO 45001:2018 standard must attend this course.

PREREQUISITES

Recommend prior knowledge: *Delegates are recommended to have knowledge of the requirements of ISO 45001 which may be gained by work experience in the domain of Occupational Health and Safety.*

Alternatively delegates are expected to acquire adequate knowledge on their own on the following:-

- a) Knowledge of the requirements of ISO 45001
- b) Knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Management System elements and concepts
- c) The purpose and benefits of a Hazard identification and risk assessment
- d) The principles of risk assessment and managing them
- e) Typical OH&S strategies
- f) OHSMS performance metrics, monitoring, measurement and improvement methodologies

On attending this program, participants will have:

- An appreciation of the importance of OHSMS in business operations.
- Knowledge of requirements of the ISO 45001 standard
- An understanding of the approach towards implementing the OHSMS
- An understanding of the approach to auditing the requirements of the Standard from the 1st, 2nd and 3rd party perspective

PROGRAM METHODS

EVALUATION & CERTIFICATION

There will be two types of assessments, continuous assessment, and examination. Methods and duration of Examination: Classroom Exam – 2 hours, OR Virtual Exam – 2 hours, OR E-Assessment (CQI online examination) – 1 hour & 45 minutes. The method of examination will depend on course delivery mode with the priority of E-Assessment.

Electronic devices, including laptops and mobile phones, are not permitted into the examination room. Delegates will also be assessed on the basis of their progress throughout the exercises. Delegates who successfully complete both the examination and the continuous assessment will be awarded a Certificate of Achievement and will satisfy the formal training requirements for CQI-IRCA ISO 45001 Auditor Certification scheme.

Delegates who do not successfully complete both the examination and the continuous assessment will be awarded a Certificate of Attendance for attending the course as per the duration of the course. They possess the right to resit examination once within 12 months since the last day of training course.
